

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – RecordMax Jackson Transitions Out of Original Facility and Contracts with Key Partners on Recovery Efforts

The RecordMax Companies feel fortunate to announce several key events in the recovery efforts from the tornado that struck our North Jackson, MS area facilities on April 4th. The final tallies on records affected by moisture have occurred over recent weeks and we've been working closely with Jackson area customers and several strategic partners for completing the restoration process.

A Transition Out of the Original Jackson Area Records Center

As many of our Jackson area customers are aware, the largest impact on RecordMax in Jackson from the tornado in April was to the original records center facility where we began operations ten years ago. This facility, constructed of concrete & steel, suffered significant damage to upper areas of the structure and the roof. The end result is that the building must be torn down & demolished. If not for founder Bob Lloyd's commitment to doing things right and making the necessary investments in building a premium facility (in combination with the diligent efforts of the disaster response team and several key contractors), the impact on customers could have been far worse. Of the approximately 95,000 cubic feet of records stored in this facility at the time of the tornado, less than 500 cubic feet of boxed material was affected by moisture. Customers with affected records were given ample opportunity to review the contents of these boxes and make the decision whether to destroy the records or have them recovered. All non-affected customer assets have since been relocated to a temporary facility while a new building is being constructed.

RecordMax Contracts with KLLM and BMS Cat

We're fortunate to have relationships with some real professionals in the logistics and business continuity industries. When the tornado hit, a key friend out of Gulfport, **Mr. Johnny Fayard**, contacted Jackson area KLLM operator **Jim Richards** on our behalf. Jim had two freezer trailers onsite the next day (a Saturday); going above & beyond the call of duty to help protect our customer's information. KLLM has now been hired to provide additional logistics support in moving records to & from restoration facilities in Ft. Worth, TX. In a similar vein, BMS Catastrophe, a leader in document restoration services, sprung into action to help RecordMax as well. **Dennis McKinley** of BMS literally left Texas the evening of the tornado; arriving in Jackson about 3:00am...sleeping in his truck in front of our building to assure he was available when needed. While the BMS team's efforts are further described in other communications, they have now been hired for document restoration through freeze drying of those information assets requested by customers to be recovered. All recovered boxes will be re-packed into new containers and re-shelved upon return from Ft. Worth. A BIG THANKS to Johnny Fayard as well as everyone at BMS & KLLM!
